**Summary of a visit-** translation

This is a 16 years old female referred by Prof. Constantini.

7 years ago she had brain hemorrhage. An aneurysm was detected. She underwent closure of aneurysm. Epileptic attacks – treated with Topamax. Left Hemiparesis.

There are no complaints of visual fields disorders, few non-specific defects, appears within normal range.

Visual acuity – right 6/7.5 , left 6/6. Normal color vision. Complete eye movements, equal reacting pupils, left facialis. Right fundus – color and limits are normal.

Concavity 0.5, preserved rim. Left eye – color and limits are normal. Concavity 0.4, sectorial temporal pallor , normal macular reflex. Summary – no edema of discs.

There is no evidence of optic neuropathy.
